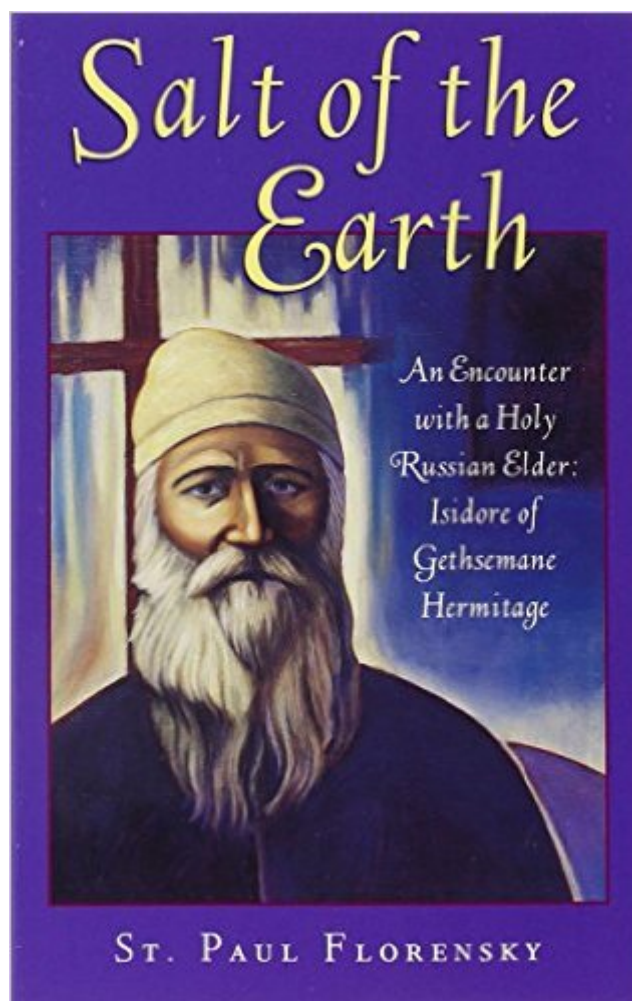

## Synopsis

Salt of the Earth is the heartwarming biography of Hieromonk Isidore (1814-1908), the great Elder of Gethsemane Hermitage in Russia. Radiant with Christ-like love and childlike simplicity, Elder Isidore lived in another world, yet kept both feet firmly planted on the ground. He was one of those whom Christ called the salt of the earth (Matt. 5:13) a repository of the rare otherworldly savor of ancient Christianity. In Salt of the Earth, both the life and personality of Elder Isidore have been captured with remarkable clarity by the Elder's spiritual son, New Martyr Paul Florensky (1937). He takes the reader directly into Fr. Isidore's world, so that by the time the book is finished, the Elder is already a dear friend. This revised second edition contains additional material on the Elder by Metropolitan Benjamin (Fedchenkov).

Paul Florensky, also known as the "Russian Leonardo da Vinci" has produced a wonderfully written account of the life of a Christian Elder (known in the ancient Orthodox world as a Staretz or Geronda). Florensky provides intimate details of his experiences with Elder Isidore, including his humble cell, his endless generosity, his love for all living creations, his asceticism, advice, favorite prayers, and many miracles. Packed with gems, this is a book you will want to read again. If you like it as much as me, you'll also love "Athonite Fathers and Athonite Matters" which is another book containing the lives of numerous other inspiring Elders of Christianity.

The author himself is regarded a saint--who was a one of the greatest and most highly regarded Russian intellects during the period of the communist oppression, while at the same time a devout and humble Orthodox priest, who found the living truth in the life of this "fool-for Christ's sake", the reclusive monk Isidore. There is an introductory section on Fr Florensky, and then his simple, but beautifully constructed tribute to this obscure personage, completely invisible to the world, who perhaps never would otherwise have been known. This is one of those occasional books that I read in a borrowed copy, but then am compelled to buy to share with a friend.

A simple and beautiful account of an encounter with a simple and beautiful man. Glory be to God.
