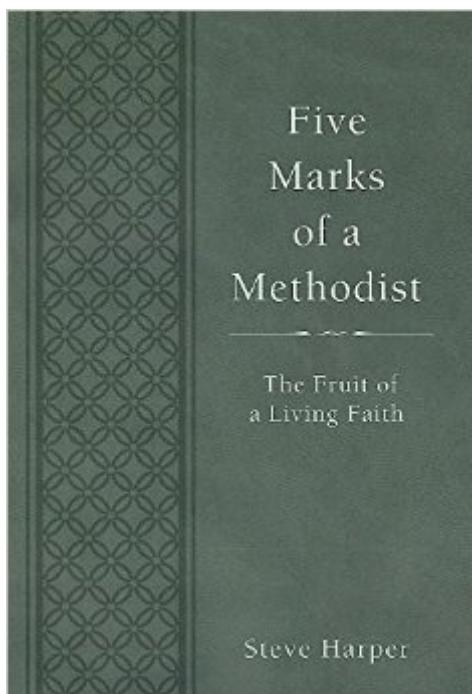

The writing for such a small book is deep and theological. I did find The Character of a Methodist to be a better read and good prerequisite to the Five Marks. Need a leader with good Bible knowledge to lead a book study.

Steve Harper bases this book on John Wesley's The Character of a Methodist. In 1742 Mr. Wesley published this little treatise to refute the false claims critics were making against the members of his societies, A Methodist Loves God to me was a little slow getting underway but comes to ita point, changing from churchianity to Christianity, from membership to discipleship. God for His love is personal to every person. A Methodist Gives Thanks; for each has the sure knowledge that God loves him or her, that prayers are received in His love. A Methodist Prays Constantly, and here Steve Harper lifts up liturgical prayer as essential as spontaneous prayer. Based on the Bible, it leads us to pray beyond our usual line of thought or concern, with the example of John Wesley. A Methodist Loves Others brings us to respond to Jesus' New Commandment, that we love one another just as he loves us. We do this in daily segments, 'one day at a time'.
